What to Bring & What to Wear Checklist

## Instrument/No Music:

Instrument/No Wuste.	
Concert Instrument	
Make sure your instrument has proper identification and is secured with luggage straps if it will be checked. Use bubble wrap inside case to minimize movement. Also, if your instrument will be carried on, check your case thoroughly to make sure there are no prohibited items inside (ex. razor blades, reed clippers, valve oil, etc.) Please put these items in your checked luggage.	
Student Clothing Needs: (Chaperones please see below)	
<ul> <li>Wednesday: Band - Band Polo for travel. Winterguard - #TeamTexas shirts for travel.</li> <li>Thursday: All - Green Practice or Dragon T-shirt.</li> <li>Friday: All - Disney 2018 Trip T-shirt.</li> <li>Saturday: Band - Section shirt* or Band Polo All Band students should wear or bring their Polo shirts for the "You're Instrumental" Workshop. Winterguard - ¾ Sleeve Tee.</li> <li>*Drumline members should wear Drumline shirts as opposed to sub-section shirts.</li> <li>Sunday: Band - "Siren's Call" Friday T-shirt, or any black or green Dragon T-shirt.</li> <li>Winterguard - WGI shirt or Show shirt.</li> </ul>	
<b>Note</b> : Students may wear shorts or pants as desired, but all attire must conform to CISD dress code. Also, remember to bring comfortable walking shoes!	
<u>Chaperones</u> : We would prefer you match the students' attire as closely as possible, but any Band or Carroll Dragon attire is acceptable for the weekend. <b>However, please wear Trip T-shirt when noted</b> .	
Miscellaneous:	
Proper TSA Identification – Driver's license, School ID, or Passport required.  Phone, ipod, chargers, cards, books, study materials, Trip Itinerary.  Toiletries, prescription medication, sunscreen, sunglasses, hat, sweatshirt/rain jacket, Nalgene bottle.  Remember all liquids must be 3 oz. or under and in a one-quart ziploc bag to go through security. Any items larger than 3 oz. (such as sunscreen) should be packed in checked luggage.  **Sack dinner** for Wednesday to eat at airport or on plane. There may not be enough time to purchase a meal at the DFW airport, and we will not be eating on arrival at the hotel.	
<u>Spending Money:</u>	
Meals: If you are planning on eating 3 full meals each day, you will be need money for 4 meals during this trip – one for each day we are at Disney World. Breakfast is provided at the hotel, and you will be given 4 meal vouchers which can be used for lunch or dinner at any Walt Disney World Park. Winterguard members and chaperones will receive 3 vouchers, one for each day at the parks, and will need money for 5 meals (1 each day, Thursday through Saturday, and 2 on Sunday).  Participating restaurants are listed on the vouchers, which you will receive with your Disney ticke  Money for souvenirs, snacks, etc. at theme parks and hotel. Debit cards must have credit option.	
VISA, MasterCard, AmEx, Diners, & Discover are accepted at WDW, and ATM's are available throughout parks.	

## Luggage Guidelines:

Students on **AA** flights may bring one piece of luggage to check (50 lb. weight limit), one carry-on (instrument, or instrument inside of it), and one personal bag. **No instruments** will be checked.

Students on **Charter** Flight may bring one **small to medium size** piece of luggage to check, one carry-on (small instrument, or instrument inside of it), and one personal bag.\* **All large instruments** will be checked.

\*If possible, please try to limit your luggage to one carry on in the following dimensions:

45 inches overall, or 22 inches long x 14 inches wide x 9 inches tall (duffels or soft sided bags are best), and one personal bag.
